ACHILLEA (Yarrow)

<u>millifolium Appleblossom</u>: (Hybrid Yarrow) Blooms open white, mature to soft pink in June-September; Height: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, cut flower, dried flower, nectarous plant. (Zones 4-9)

<u>millefolium Red Beauty</u>: (Milfoil Yarrow) Aromatic, finely divided foliage; rusty orange-red flowers in July; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flower, nectarous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>millefolium Summer Pastels</u>: (Milfoil Yarrow) Aromatic, finely divided foliage; mixed pastel shades, flowers in July; Height: 18"-24"; Spread 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flower, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>x Moonshine</u>: (Hybrid Yarrow) Aromatic, gray-green, deeply cut foliage; canary-yellow flowers in July-August; Height: 24"; Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, cut flower, dried flower, nectarous plant. (Zone 4)

ACONITUM (Monkshood)

<u>x cammarum</u>: (Bicolor Monks Hood) Strong upright plants with branching spikes of hooded flowers. Foliage is deeply divided into narrow segments; white flowers with good blue edge; Vigorous, well-branched cultivar; flowers June-August. Height: 40". Plant in partial shade in cool, fertile, moisture-retentive soil. Use for shady perennial border, wild gardens, excellent cut flower, deer resistant. (Zones 4-8)

x cammarum 'Stainless Steel': (Monks Hood) Lavish steel blue shafts are the great reward of this easy-to-cultivate perennial.

Cloaking strong stems, the glossy grayish green foliage is deeply divided into narrow fingers. Blue flowers form mid June-August. Height: 40". Plant in partial shade in cool, fertile, moisture-retentive soil. Use for shady perennial border, wild gardens, excellent cut flower, deer resistant. (Zones 4-8)

<u>napellus</u>: (Monks Hood) Dark green, glossy, upright foliage; deep blue flowers in September; Height 36"-48"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, cut flower, deer resistant. (Zone 4)

AEGOPODIUM (Bishop's Weed, Snow-on-the-Mountain)

<u>p.Variegatum</u>: Green and white variegated foliage; insignificant flowers in June; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 24". Plant in any moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. (Zone 3)

AGASTACHE (Giant Hyssop)

<u>foeniculum 'Golden Jubilee'</u>: This new hyssop is creating a buzz in the garden world primarily for its rich yellow to chartreuse foliage. A compact grower to only 20" tall and 15" wide, it bears in Summer 4" purple spikes much loved by hummers, butterflies & bees. The foliage is nicely serrated and heavily mint-scented. This "Hyssop" loves heat and makes nice cut flowers. (Zones 5-8)

AJUGA (Bugleweed)

<u>reptans Bronze Beauty</u>: Tight crumpled cushions of kinky, curled, purple/bronze leaves with a metallic sheen; 8" strong grower with attractive deep bronze foliage, blue flower. Sun/Shade. Flowers May-June. (Zones 3-9)

<u>x. Chocolate Chip:</u> Small, narrow, rich chocolate brown, mat-forming foliage; tiny spikes of dark lavender-blue flowers in May-June; grow in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Height: 2"-4"; Spread: 18". (Zone 4)

genevenis: (Geneva Bugleweed) Mat forming, green foliage, blue flowers in June; Height 4"-8"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for groundcover. (Zone 4)

reptans Silver Beauty: White and green variegated leaves, 6" blue flower spikes. Sun/Shade. Flowers May-June. (Zones 3-9)

ALCEA (Hollyhock)

<u>rosea Chater's Double Mix</u>: Tall columns of fluffy double blooms; available in a mix of colors. Height to 7'. Full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 3-8)

rosea Chater's Double Pink: Tall columns of fluffy double blooms; Pink. Height to 7'. Full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 3-8)

rosea Chater's Double Purple: Tall columns of fluffy double blooms; Purple. Height to 7'. Full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 3-8)

rosea Chater's Double Red: Tall columns of fluffy double blooms; Red. Height to 7'. Full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 3-8)

ALCEA (continued)

rosea Chater's Double Yellow: Tall columns of fluffy double blooms; Yellow. Height to 7'. Full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 3-8)

<u>rosea Summer Camival Mix:</u> Shortest at 30" Plant 18" apart. Blooms first year with double flowers in red ,white, yellow, pink and purple. (Zones 3-8)

<u>rosea The Watchman</u>: (Niger/Nigra) Single flowers of rich, deep maroon, verging on black. Height to 6', full sun, flowers June-July. (Zones 5-8)

ALCHEMILLA (Lady's Mantle)

<u>vulgaris Thriller</u>: Gray-green foliage; chartreuse flowers in June; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 18"-24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, cut flower. (Zone 3)

ALYSSUM (Mountain Alyssum)

montanum Mountain Gold: Silver-gray foliage; bright yellow flowers in May-June; Height: 10"-12"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for rock garden, edging. (Zone 4)

AMPELOPSIS (Variegated Porcelain Vine)

<u>brevipedunculata "Elegans":</u> Strong growing vine with large, grape-leaf shaped green and white speckled foliage. In autumn, the ¼ inch berry fruits mature to a unique porcelain blue color. Fruiting is best in full sun. Best variegation is in partial shade. Creamy white flowers bloom in midsummer. Height: 10-25 feet. (Zones 4-8)

ANCHUSA (Summer Forget-me-not)

<u>capensis Blue Angel:</u> Tall stems of blue flowers shooting up from clumps of bright green leaves. The long narrow leaves are soft, but rough and hairy when touched. The basic requirements are full sun and well-drained soil. This cultivar 'Blue Angel' is a more compact form of the species, growing only 1-2 feet. (Zones 3-8)

ANEMONE

<u>hupehensis September Charm</u>: Slightly hairy, lobed foliage; rose pink flowers in September-October; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 18"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun, and protection from winter wind. Use for border garden, woodland garden. (Zone 4)

<u>tomentosa Robustissima:</u> Nice spreading anemone, forming a large mound of attractively cut foliage with plenty of pink flowers in late summer.; Height: 18-24"; Spread 24+". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, woodland garden, cut flower. (Zone 3)

ANTHEMIS (Hardy Marguerite Daisy)

<u>tinctoria kelwayi</u>: Finely divided, gray-green foliage; bright yellow flowers in June-July; Height: 36"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil, full sun. Use for border garden, cut flower, dye plant. (Zone 4)

AQUILEGA (Columbine)

<u>x Biedermeier Dwarf Mix</u>: Bushy foliage; pastel shades, flowers in June; Height: 12"; Spread: 15". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, rock garden, birds, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

Dragonfly: Full range of colors on dwarf compact 18" plants. (Zone 3)

<u>x McKana's Giant Mix</u>: Delicate, fan-shaped foliage; mixed colors, flowers in June; Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, birds, nectareous plant, (Zone 3)

vulgaris Nora Barlow: unique fully double flowers in delightful combination of red, pink and green. (Zone 3)

<u>vulgaris Clementine Blue:</u> A spectacular new generation of columbine, this selection sports vibrant blue flowers that resemble a double clematis blossom. They face upward for best display and are spurless. Makes an excellent cut flower. (Zone 3)

<u>vulgaris Clementine Mix:</u> A spectacular new generation of columbine, this selection sports mix pink, white, salmon, blue & purple flowers that resemble a double clematis blossom. They face upward for best display and are spurless. Makes an excellent cut flower. (Zone 3)

<u>maritime Alba</u>: Round clumps of grass-like foliage; rose-pink flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-12"; Spread: 8"-12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for rock garden, cut flower, dried flower. (Zone 3)

<u>maritime laucheana Rosea (Splendens)</u>: Round clumps of grass-like foliage; rose-pink flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-12"; Spread: 10"-12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for rock garden, cut flower, dried flower. (Zone 3)

<u>pseudoarmeria Joystick Red:</u> Will send up flowers to one-foot height, flowers up to golfball sized; can have two or three shades of red popping out of a single clump, Joystick blooms its first year. Height 6-8" (Zone 3)

X hybrida Dwarf Ornament Mix: Mix of white to mauve flowers. Height 10-12" (Zone 3)

ARTEMISIA

<u>lactiflora Ghizou</u>: (White Mugwort) Dark-stemmed, bronze foliage; fragrant creamy white flowers in August-September; Height: ;48"; Spread: 18"-20". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, specimen, cut flower, dried flower. (Zone 4)

<u>x Powis Castle</u>: (Hybrid Wormwood) Aromatic, silver foliage; no flowers. Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers. (Zone 5)

<u>stelleriana Silver Brocade</u>: (Old Lady) Aromatic, silver-gray foliage; yellow flowers in July-August; Height: 18"-24"; Spread: 12"-18"++. Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers. (Zone 3)

<u>schmidtiana Silver Mound</u>: (Satiny Wormwood) Silver foliage; no flowers. Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12". Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, rock garden. (Zone 3)

ARUNCUS (Goat's Beard)

<u>dioicus</u>: (Goat's Beard) Divided foliage; white flowers in June-July; Height: 5'-6'; Spread: 4'. Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, specimen, cut flower. (Zone 4)

x <u>arendsii Fanal (Red)</u>: (False Spirea) Reddish bronze foliage; dark red flowers in June; Height: 22"; Spread: 18"-24". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade. Use for border garden, cut flower, dried flower, nectarous plant. (Zone 4)

x <u>arendsii Ostrich Plume:</u> (False Spirea) Graceful, medium green foliage; salmon –pink flowers in July; Height: 32"; Spread: 24". Grow in rich, moist soil in part shade. (Zone 4)

<u>macrophylla</u>: Heart-shaped, textured foliage; blue flowers in May-June; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 15"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade. Use for border garden, containers, cut flower. (Zone 4)

<u>macrophylla Jack Frost</u>: A sight to behold! The leaves of 'Jack Frost' are intricately detailed with a crackle-like finish. Though the leaves are dark green, they have a heavily frosted overlay which allows only the green veining to show through. From mid to late spring, baby blue, forget-me-not type blossoms are held in clusters several inches above the shimmering foliage. The effect is breathtaking. davidii 3 in One: Pink, white and deep violet flowers in a 6'-8' clump of three plants. (Zone 5)

<u>carpatica White Clips</u>: (Carpathian Bellflower) Dark green foliage; white flowers in June-August; Height: 6"-9"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun. Use for border garden, rock garden, edging, groundcover, rock wall. (Zone 4)

<u>gargainca</u> <u>Gold Clips</u>: (Carpathian Bellflower) Golden scalloped foliage; mid-blue flowers in June-august; Height: 4"-6"; Spread: 10"-12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun. Use for border garden, rock garden, edging, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>glomerata Superba (Purple)</u>: (Clustered Bellflower) Dark green, somewhat hairy, basal foliage; deep purple flowers in June; Height: 24"; spread: 15"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun to pt shade. Use for border garden, cut flower. (Zone 4)

<u>medium Calycanthema Mixed</u>: (Cup & Saucer) Rosettes of hairy, green foliage; mixed colors, flowers in May-June; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flower. (Zone 5)

persicifolia Blue: (Peachleaf Bellflower) Evergreen, basal foliage; blue flowers in June; Height: 24"-36"; spread: 12"-18". plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, cut flower. (Zone 3)

persicifolia Kelly's Gold: (Peachleaf Bellflower) Golden-leaved version of peach-leaved bellflower. This is a rosette-forming, upright perennial that typically grows on stiff stems to 24" tall. Features large, outward facing, bell-shaped flowers (to 1.5" long) that are white tinged with blue at the edges. Easily grown in average, medium wet, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade. Montana (Blue): (Bachelor's Button) Lance-shaped, gray-green foliage; blue flowers in June; Height: 24"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

CENTRANTHUS (Jupiter's Beard)

<u>ruber</u>: Rather fleshy, gray-green foliage; red shades, flowers in June-July; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 5)

<u>ruber Alba</u>: Rather fleshy, gray-green foliage; white shades, flowers in June-July; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 5)

CERASTIUM (Snow-in-the-Summer)

tomentosum: Wooly silver foliage; white flowers in June; Height: 4"-6"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for rock garden, groundcover, rock wall. (Zone 3)

CERATOSTIGMA (Leadwort)

<u>plumbaginoides</u>: 12" ground cover with deep blue flowers in August-October. Red foliage in the fall. Late emerging, good overplanting for bulbs. Plant in full sun to part shade. (Zones 6-9)

CHELONE (Turtlehead)

<u>Iyonii Hot Lips</u>: Short spikes of rosy-pink flowers that look like a turtle's head with its mouth open delight children and other passersby in late summer and early fall. Long-blooming perennial that thrives in moist woodland conditions. This variety has bronze-green foliage that turns a deeper green than the species, but is equally as showy. The upright, red stems provide additional interest throughout the season. Height: 36"; Spread: 24"-30" (Zone 3)

CHRYSANTHEMUM (Siberian Daisy)

<u>zawadskii latilobium Clara Curtis</u>: Deeply lobed, mum-like foliage; clear pink flowers in September; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, birds. (Zone 4)

CIMICIFUGA (Black Cohosh)

<u>racemosa</u>: (Black Snakeroot) Large, deeply cut, toothed foliage; a Wisconsin Native plant; pure white flowers in July-August; Height: 6'-8'; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. use for native woodlands, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

<u>ramosa Brunette</u>: Very dark purple, almost black foliage; bottle brush flowers open light pink and fade to creamy white in August thru September; Height: 48"-60"; Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. (Zone 4-8)

<u>ramose Atropurpurea</u>: (Snakeroot) Large, deeply cut, toothed, bronze foliage; white flowers in July-August; Height: 5'-6'; Spread: 24"-48". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for woodland garden, cut flowers. (Zone 4)

CLEMATIS

<u>x Comtesse de Bouchard (Rose Pink)</u>: Oval, pale to mid-green, twining foliage; satiny rose flowers in July-October; Height: vine 10'; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Jackmanii (Purple)</u>: Oval, pale to mid-green, twining foliage; dark purple flowers in July-October; Height: vine 10'; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Jackmanii Superba (Purple)</u>: Rich velvet purple, 5" open flowers. More rounded and slightly larger flower than Jackmanii. Blooms July & September. Height: vine 10'; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Ernest Markham (Red)</u>: Oval, pale to mid-green, twining foliage; red flowers in July-September; Height: vine 10'; spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 3)

CLEMATIS (Continued)

<u>x Henryi (White)</u>: Oval, pale to mid-green, twining foliage; creamy white flowers in June-July; Height: vine 10'; spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 3)

<u>x Nellie Moser (bicolor)</u>: Oval, pale to mid-green, twining foliage; pink bars on light mauve flowers in June; Height vine 10'; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for vine, wall cover. (Zone 3)

<u>Bees Jubilee(bicolor pink white)</u>: Delicate pink with deep red bar down the middle of each petal with yellow anthers. Does not fade in the sun, blooms May, June and September. (Zone 3)

Belle of Woking (light blue double): Fully double light blue flowers in June-September; Height: vine 12'. (Zone 4)

<u>Dutchess of Edinburgh (double white):</u> Rosette shaped double white flowers with yellow anthers. Blooms May, June and September. (Zone 3)

<u>Hagley (rich pink)</u>: Medium-size rich pink flowers with ruffly edges and #E069A8dish anthers. Vigorous grower with 5-6" flowers blooming June and September. (Zone 4)

Niobe (Dark Red): Very dark ruby-red pointed petals with gold anthers. Blooms June, August and September. A true red! (Zone 4)

<u>Pink Champagne (Deep Pink):</u> 5" deep rosy-pink, very free flowering, compact plant. Also known as Kakio, from Japan. Blooms May, June, August and September. It is a real eye catcher. (Zone 4)

<u>Pink Fantasy (Pink)</u>: Beautiful 4-5" pale pink flower with darker pink bar and very attractive dark anthers. Blooms late June-September. A good repeat bloomer! (Zone 4b)

Royalty (dark purple double): Compact, early, large-flowered climber. Bears semi-double, purple-mauve flowers 4" across with yellow anthers in early summer, followed by smaller, single flowers from midsummer to autumn.

Height: 6'; Spread: 36". (Zones 4-9)

paniculata Sweet Autumn Clematis: Handsome climbing vine displays billowy masses of fragrant creamy-white flowers against leathery dark green leaves in fall. Seed heads are silvery. Great for arbors, fences, and cut flowers. Deciduous. Full to partial sun. Fast-growing vine to 20 feet long. (Zone 4)

CONVALLARIA (Lily of the Valley)

grandiflora Early Sunrise: (Tickseed) Lance-shaped foliage; double golden yellow flowers in June-July; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, cut flowers, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 4)

grandiflora Rising Sun: (Tickseed) A delightful award winning new Coreopsis with large 2" double flowers. The exquisite golden flowers have unique fringed petals and a mahogany-red center. A very long bloomer, beginning in late spring and continuing through late summer. Recipient of the 2005 Fleuroselect Gold Medal. Deer resistant. (Zone 4)

<u>grandiflora Sunfire</u>: Similar to Rising Sun but rounder petals and drops of mahogany-red at the flower petal base. Very attractive. (Zone 4)

<u>grandiflora Sunray</u>: An extravagant bloomer, C. 'Sunray' will light up the garden with its double, deep golden yellow flowers. This show will last from late spring to late summer if spent flowers are removed. This variety is especially compact and floriferous. The cheery golden blooms make excellent companions for purple blooming perennials such as Salvia 'May Night'. Height: 18"-24"; Spread: 12"-24" (Zone 4)

<u>grandiflora "Walcoreop' Flying Saucers:</u> Compact coreopsis cultivar which features solitary, yellow, daisy-like flowers (2" diameter) with yellow rays (lobed at the tips) and darker yellow center disks atop slender, erect stems rising 18-20" tall. Flowers

<u>rosea</u>: (Pink Tickseed) Finely divided thread-like foliage; light pink flowers in July-August; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 4)

<u>rosea American Dream</u>: strong grower that displays bright pink, daisy-type flowers with yellow centers from early summer thru early fall. Its attractive, fern-like foliage is similar to C. 'Moonbeam' though its habit is more even and compact. Height: 8"-16"; Spread: 12"-18" (Zone 4)

<u>rosea Sweet Dreams (white/raspberry)</u>: Big bicolor flowers are 1½" across, a third larger than the species. White ray petals with a raspberry base surround yellow centers in June-July. Plant in full sun. (Zones 4-9)

<u>verticillata Zagreb</u>: (Threadleaf Coreopsis) Finely divided thread-like foliage; golden yellow flowers in July-September; Height: 12"-18"; spread: 15"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, edging, cut flowers, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 3)

CORONILLA (Crownvetch)

c. varia Penngift: Vigorous erosion-stopping groundcover. Pinkish-white pea-like flowers. (Zone 4)

CORYDALIS

<u>flexuosa China Blue:</u> A spectacular plant with fragrant, light blue flowers and glaucous, finely cut foliage. Best in a moist location with loose, leafy soil. Blooms May to June. (Zone 5)

<u>Iutea</u>: (Yellow Fumitory) Dainty, fern-like, somewhat glaucous foliage; yellow flowers in June-August; Height: 8"-12"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for border garden, rock garden, woodland garden. (Zone 4)

<u>Blackberry Wine</u>: Blue-green, ferny leaves provide a backdrop for hundreds of fragrant flowers the color of blackberry wine; with a strong cascading habit. Height: 12-16"; Spread: 24". Part shade. (Zones 5-11)

DELOSPERMA (Hardy Ice Plant)

<u>cooperi Mesa Verde(pink)</u>: Succulent, needle-like leaves studded with fluorescent pink, daisy-like flowers measuring 2" across make this semi-evergreen groundcover a sight to behold. Hot, sunny conditions keep the flowers coming all summer long. In fall and winter, the foliage develops good red fall color. (Zone 5)

DELPHINIUM

<u>bellamosum</u>: Deep violet flowers are produced from early to late summer on numerous heavily-branched spikes rather than one central stalk. Deadheading faded spikes by cutting them back to the main stem will encourage repeat blooming. The foliage of 'Bellamosum' is naturally compact and bushy, requiring minimal staking. This selection is breathtaking in fresh bouquets. Plant in fully sun to part shade. Use for cut flowers, birds. (Zone 3)

<u>Blue Butterfly</u>: Dwarf delphinium, unlike the tall, spiky cultivars, this little beauty forms compact mounds of well-branched foliage. Puts on a spectacular show of 1-1/2 inch deep blue flowers which smother the lacy leaves. Use as edging or in containers. Height: 10"-12". (Zone 3)

(Magic Fountain/Pennant Series)

<u>x Dark Blue (Dark Bee)</u>: Divided, mid-green foliage; dark blue with dark bee, flowers in July, reblooming; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 15"-24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>x Lilac Pink (White Bee)</u>: Divided, mid-green foliage; lilac pink shades with white bee, flowers in July, reblooming; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 15"-24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>x elatum Black Knight</u>: Divided, mid-green foliage; dark purple with black bee, flowers in July, reblooming; Height: 48"-72"; spread: 24"-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>deltoides Artic Fire (Maiden Pinks)</u>: Deep green, mat-forming foliage; red-eyed, white flowers in May-June; Height: 8"-12"; Spread: 16". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for containers, rock garden, groundcover, nectareous plant, birds. (zone 3)

<u>deltoides confettie Cherry Red:</u> produces small, candy apple red blossoms atop relatively long stems. <u>deltoides Zing Rose (Maiden Pinks)</u>: deep green, mat-forming foliage; large, deep red flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-12"; Spread: 12"-16". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, rock garden, groundcover, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 3)

<u>deltoides Zing Salmon (Maiden Pinks)</u>: deep green, mat-forming foliage; large, salmon pink flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-12"; Spread: 12"-16". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, rock garden, groundcover, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 3)

gratianopolitanus Bath's Pink (Cheddar Pinks): Mat-forming, silvery blue foliage; fragrant, fringed, single soft pink flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-8"; Spread: 12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for containers, rock garden, edging, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 3)

<u>gratianopolitanus Firewitch</u>: Spreading, low-growing form with deep blue-green foliage and magenta blooms in May-June. Height 6". Long blooming. Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for containers, rock garden, groundcover, nectareous plant, birds. (Zones 3-8)

DIANTHUS (Continued)

gratianopolitanus Grandiflorus: Produces numerous scented rose-pink flowers (to 1.5" diameter) singly or in twos atop wiry stems (to 12" tall) arising from tufted mounds of grassy, gray-green, linear foliage. Flowers are larger than those of most other cultivars in this species. (Zone 3)

pulmarius Spring Beauty Mix: Blend of "Cottage Pinks". Double flowers in rose, salmon, pink and white (Garden Pinks). (Zone 3)

pulmarius Velvet N Lace: Highly fragrant, velvety purple to burgundy (some look black) flowers with white ruffled edges. (Zone3)

DICENTRA (Bleeding Heart)

<u>eximia</u>: (Fringed Bleeding Heart) Fern-like, gray-green foliage; rosy pink flowers in May-June, reblooming; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, woodland garden. (Zone 3)

<u>x Luxuriant</u>: (Hybrid Bleeding Heart) Blue-green fern-like foliage; cherry-red flowers in May-June, reblooming; Height: 15"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full sun. Use for border garden, containers, woodland garden. (Zone 3)

<u>Gold Heart</u>: Heart-shaped flowers hung along arching stems overlooking a vigorous growth of deeply lobed golden foliage; pink flowers in April-May; Height: 24"; (Zones 3-9)

<u>King of Hearts:</u> Astonishing vigor; sun and heat tolerance; bright rose-red, heart-shaped flowers that appear from late spring into fall; and lacy, soft gray-green foliage. Unlike the Common Bleeding Heart, D. 'King of Hearts' will not go dormant in midsummer as long as the soil is kept moist. Rather, it will enchant passersby all season long. <u>spectabilis Alba (White)</u>: Glaucous, divided, somewhat ferny foliage; may go dormant in hot summers; pure white heart-shaped flowers in May-June; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

DIGITALIS (Foxglove)

grandiflora (Yellow): Evergreen, lance-shaped foliage; pale yellow flowers in June-July; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. Rabbit and Deer Resistant. (Zone 4)

<u>x mertonensis (Strawberry)</u>: Evergreen, lance-shaped foliage; strawberry-pink flowers in June-July; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12"-15". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. Rabbit and Deer Resistant. (Zone 5)

<u>purpurea Camelot Lavender</u>: Tall, stately spikes of large, lavender flowers with burgundy interior spotting grace this perennial in early summer. Numerous secondary flower spikes extend the bloom time well into summer if plants are deadheaded. When not in bloom, enjoy the large rosettes of fuzzy, green leaves. Height: 36"; Spread: 24"-30". Rabbit and Deer Resistant. (Zone 4)

<u>purpurea Camelot Rose</u>: Tall, stately spikes of large, deep rose pink flowers with burgundy interior spotting grace this perennial in early summer. Numerous secondary flower spikes extend the bloom time well into summer if plants are deadheaded. When not in bloom, enjoy the large rosettes of fuzzy, green leaves. Height: 36"; Spread: 24"-30". <u>purpurea Excelsor (Mixed):</u> Tall spires of large, well-spaced, tubular flowers in pastel shades of purple, pink, creamy-yellow or white, spotted maroon or purple inside, from May to July. These pastel foxgloves are perfect for the back of a large cottage-style border. Height: 36"; Spread: 24"-30". Rabbit and Deer Resistant. (Zone 4)

<u>purpurea Foxy:</u> Grows in a rosette form with large green leaves, sending a large 1-2 foot tall flower spike through the middle of the rosette Mid-Spring. Flowers are white with purple to maroon spotting on the inside of the flower. Height: 36"; Spread: 24"-30". Rabbit and Deer Resistant. (Zone 4)

DORONICUM (Leopard's Bane)

<u>purpurea</u>: Rough, lance-shaped, toothed foliage; decorative seed heads; a Wisconsin Native plant; rose-purple flowers in July-August; Height: 36"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for Native Prairie, border, containers, cut flowers, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 3)

ECHINOPS (Globe Thistle)

<u>ritro</u>: Glossy, green foliage with downy reverse; steel-blue flowers in July; Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 24"-36". Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. use for border garden, cut flowers, dried flowers, nectareous plant, birds. (Zone 4)

ERYNGUIM (Sea Holly)

<u>alpinum Blue Star:</u> Prickly, blue-green foliage with large, blue flowers which are surrounded by a ruffled collar. The entire plant has a silver metallic sheen. Vigorous. Quite a conversation piece. Thrives in sunny gardens and ordinary soil. Blooms mid-to-late summer. Drought tolerant. Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 20"-26" (Zone 4)

EUONYMUS (Wintercreeper)

<u>fortunei Coloratus</u>: (Purple-leaf) Dark green, leathery, spreading foliage, reddish purple in fall; no flowers. Height: 15"-18"; Spread: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>fortunei Emerald Gaiety</u>: (Variegated) Bushy, dark green foliage with white margin; no flowers. Height: 12"; Spread: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for groundcover, low hedge. (Zone 4)

EUPATORIUM

<u>rugosum Chocolate</u>: (White Snakeroot) Greenish-brown foliage, deep purple stems; white flowers in August-September; Height: 36"-50; Spread: 30". Plant in rich, moist soil in part sun to part shade. Use for back of border, marginal plant, cut flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>'Little Joe'</u>: Little Joe is a compact version of the treasured Joe-Pye Weed, with a smaller stature but BIGGER bloom clusters than ever before! lavender blossoms in clusters a full 10 inches across. When in full bloom, this plant is entirely topped by dome-like, fuzzy blooms -- a fabulous sight in the back of the border or patio garden! Athyrium niponicum Pictum Applecourt (Applecourt Crested Painted Fern): Heavy cresting of each metallic gray frond with red stems; no flowers. Very full appearance. Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, moist soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, shade or woodland garden. (Zone 4)

Athyrium filix-femina (Lady Fem): Fine-textured bright green fronds; a Wisconsin Native plant; no flowers. Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, moist soil in full shade to part shade. Use for native woodland, shade garden. (Zone 3)

<u>Dryopteris erythrosora Brilliance (Brilliance Autumn Fern)</u>: lustrous orange color of the newly emerging fronds which seem to glow against the backdrop of the shiny, dark green, mature fronds. The sori, which are produced in fall, are bright red. Height: 24"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, moist soil in full shade to part shade. Use for native woodland, shade garden. (Zone 5)

<u>Matteuccia struthiopteris (Ostrich Fern)</u>: Upright, dark-green fronds; a Wisconsin Native plant; no flowers. Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to full shade. Use for native woodland, shade garden. (Zone 3)

<u>Onocleo sensibilis (Sensitive Fern):</u> Sun or shade if kept wet. Aggressive grouncover. Pale green color is great nest to dark green or yellow colored foliages. Good for marshes, ditches, and boggy areas. Height 18-30" (Zone 2)

<u>Osmunda cinnamomea (Cinnamon Fern)</u>: Deep green fronds, cinnamon-brown, upright, fertile fronds; a Wisconsin Native plant; no flowers. Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, moist soil in full shade to part shade. Use for native woodland, shade garden. (Zone 3)

<u>Polystichum acrostichoides (Christmas Fern)</u>: Very dark green, glossy, evergreen fronds; no flowers. Height: 18"-24"; spread: 24". Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, shade garden, woodland garden, cut foliage. (Zone 3)

FRUITS

Raspberry Fall Gold: Yellow fruit. (Zone 3)

Raspberry Heritage: Red fruit. (Zone 4)

<u>Victoria Red Rhubarb (Rheum rhabarbarum)</u>: Green, inedible foliage with red margins, red, edible stems; use for pies, sauces, jams, and wine; yellowish white flowers in June; Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 36"-48". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for culinary plant, vegetable. (Zone 3)

<u>Strawberry, x everbearing (Eversweet):</u> Three-part, toothed foliage, spreads by runners; large, sweet fruit in June and Fall; use leaves for tea; use fresh fruit for desserts, juice, jam, syrup and wine; white flowers in June, August-September; grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Height: 6"-8"; Spread: 24"++ (Zone 4)

GAILLARDIA (Blanket Flower)

<u>aristata Arizona Sun:</u> A 2005 All-American Selection and winner of the 2005 Fleuroselect Gold Medal. This compact and uniform perennial produces masses of large, 3" diameter, fiery orange-red blooms tipped by a ring of rich flame yellow. Butterflies are highly attracted to its bright colors. Since these plants bloom from early summer into fall, they will provide continuous color in containers. Requires little care once established. They are heat tolerant and actually prefer to be grown in poorer soils. Height: 10"; Spread: 12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>aristata Bijou:</u> A petite form of the popular G. 'Goblin'. Daisy-like flowers are highly valued for their hot red and yellow hues and they attract butterflies. Since these plants bloom from early summer into fall, they will provide continuous color in containers. Requires little care once established. They are heat tolerant and actually prefer to be grown in poorer soils. Height: 10"; Spread: 15". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>aristata Oranges & Lemon:</u> Sure to take the market by storm, this blanket flower is a breakthrough in gaillardia coloring! Rather than the typical bright red and yellow flowers, 'Oranges & Lemons' PPAF looks just like it sounds--large, peachy orange flowers with yellow tips and a gold central cone. The blue-green foliage enhances this warm coloring and the round, chartreuse seed heads extend the interest after the flowers are spent. Unlike many of the older selections, this one has an improved upright habit rather than sprawling. It's simply fantastic! <u>x grandiflora Dazzler</u>: Gray-green, coarsely toothed foliaged; bright orange-yellow with maroon center, flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>x grandiflora Fanfare</u>: Fantastic new introduction that blooms all summer long; forms neat compact mounds, dramatic trumpet-shaped scarlet petals flare open to reveal bright yellow. This prolific bloomer will flower from June thru September; Height: 18"-24". (Zones 3-8)

<u>x grandiflora Goblin</u>: Gray-green, coarsely toothed foliage; red tipped yellow flowers in July-August; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

GAURA (Wand Flower)

<u>lindheimeri "Blushing Butterflies":</u> Flowers are a blush pink and are held upright by stems above the foliage. Stems culminate in racemes of open petal flowers, which open a few at a time. Very dark green foliage. More compact then Siskiyou Pink. Height: 15". (Zone 5)

<u>lindheimeri "Crimson Butterflies":</u> Hot pink flowers are held upright by short red stems slightly above the foliage. The flowers are 1/2 inch and four- petaled they appear in clumps. This New Cultivar is very compact, with very dark crimson foliage. 24" height - 24" width. (Zone 5)

<u>lindheimeri "Siskiyou Pink":</u> Green foliage has a reddish tinge. Brilliant reddish-pink flowers with white stamens. Has a tendency to revert to white. Highly valued for its long bloom time. Height: 18". (Zones 5b,6-9)

<u>lindheimeri "Whirling Butterflies":</u> Sterile, with floriferous bright white flowers and red stems that resemble butterflies above willow-like foliage. Blooms in mid-summer. Height: 30". (Zone 5b,6-9)

GERANIUM (Cranesbill)

<u>x cantabrigiense Biokovo (Pink)</u>: Aromatic, glossy green, trailing foliage, red in fall; pinkish white flowers in June-July; Height: 8"-12"; Spread: 12"-15"++. Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover. (Zone 4)

oxonianum Claridge Druce (Lilac): Dense, bushy, semi-evergreen foliage; lilac-pink flowers in July; Height: 18"-24"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Johnson's Blue</u>: Divided, mid-green foliage, bright orange-red in fall; clear blue flowers in July; Height: 15"-18"; Spread: 24". Use for border garden, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Jolly Bee</u>: Massive cupped blue flowers with large white centers and dark-maroon arteries. Very floriferous, longblooming plant from May to October Height: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. (Zone 5)

<u>pratense Hocus Pocus:</u> The subItle light purple flowers with white centers & black anthers are larger than for other dark-leafed Meadow Crane's-bills, up to two inches, extremely numerous starting either late May or in June & lasting throughout the summer. This cultivar is more compact than the species & will often remain well under two feet by two feet. The leaves are chocolately purple-black in spring, with bronzy hightlights, adding deep sea-green to the center of the leaves in summer while leaf edges remain dark, for a two-tone appearance. The large deep-cut leaves & their dark bicolor makes them an attractive accent even when not in flower. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. (Zone 5)

<u>pratense Okey Dokey:</u> Wonderful deep purple leaved variety with beautiful bluish-purple flowers. Foliage color holds up well throughout the season. Mildew resistant. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. (Zone 4)

<u>pratense Slish Splash:</u> This geranium is exceptionally beautiful and spectacular as each flower has unique bicolour markings. Some flowers are white with blue stripes whereas others have a speckled pattern in blue and white. Definitely worthy of a prominent place in the garden. (Zone 4)

<u>sanguineum Max Frei</u>: Deep purple flowers set off with darker foliage in July: Height: 8"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, containers. (Zone 4)

<u>sanguineum (Red)</u>: Finely cut, spreading foliage, crimson-red in fall; carmine-red flowers in July: Height: 12"-15"; Spread: 18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, containers. (Zone 4)

GRASSES

<u>Acorus gramineus Oborozukii</u>: (Sweet Flag) Beautiful golden foliage; Height: 10". Plant in moist location in full sun to part shade. (Zones 4-11)

<u>Briza media (Big Quaking Grass):</u> Mid-green, clump-forming foliage; golden dried heart-shaped florets shake in light breezes; violet-toned flowers in June; grow in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Height: 24"; Spread: 12". (Zone 5)

<u>Calamagrostis acutiflora Karl Foerster</u>: (Feather Reed Grass) Rich green, upright, clumping foliage; golden brown flowers in July-August; Height: 5'-6'; spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil to moist soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, massing, specimen. (Zone 4)

<u>Calamagrostis acutiflora Overdam:</u> (Feather Reed Grass) Rich green, upright, clumping foliage with white stripes; golden brown flowers in July-August; Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil to moist soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, containers, massing. (Zone 5)

<u>Calamagrostis arundinacea Brachytricha</u>: (Fall Reed Grass): Rich green, clumping foliage, bright yellow in fall; wheat-colored seed heads; green-blushed pink flowers in August-September; grow in rich, well-drained to moist soil in full sun to part shade. Height: 24-36"; Spread: 24". (Zone 5)

<u>Carex conica 'Snowlin'e:</u> A fountain of narrow dark green foliage edged in creamy white. This Japanese sedge is slow to increase but can attain 15 inches in height and 24 inches in width. (Zone 5)

<u>Carex flacca (Blue-green Sedge):</u> Fine-textured, blue-green, carnation-like foliage; insignificant flowers in June; grow in any well-drained to moist soil in full sun to part shade. Height: 6-12"; Spread: 12-24". (Zone 4)

<u>Carex glauca 'Blue Zinger':</u> Tufted, blue-gray, grassy foliage bears grass-like flowers in mid to late summer. Looks best with ample water and fertilizer, partial shade in hot summer areas. Considered drought tolerant once established, making it a valuable plant for dry, shady areas. Plant in masses for a splendid effect. Also used in containers, water, woodland and 'cottage' gardens. Height: 10-20"; Spread: 18". (Zone 5)

GRASSES (continued)

<u>Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'</u>: With its wide, leathery leaves measuring 1/4 to 1/2 inch across, this carex makes a bold statement in the shade garden. The leaves are dark green with bright white variegated edges. Small, cream, bottlebrush-like flowers are produced in midspring but are rather insignificant to the plant's ornamental value. Will grow in a variety of conditions, from nearly full sun to shade in average to moist soil. Unlike many other sedges, 'Ice Dance' is a slow to moderate spreader that should be used as a groundcover or contained in pots. Height: 12-16"; Spread: 18"-24". (Zone 5)

<u>Carex muskingumensis 'Oehme'</u>: Varigated foliage radiates up around its triangular stems like the leaves of a palm tree. Each leaf arches gracefully at the tip. Though they emerge all-green, the leaves develop broad yellow margins as they mature. This color intensifies throughout the season (best from midsummer on). Tiny flowers are carried above the leaves on long, slender stalks in early summer, though it is most often the unique foliage that is used in fresh bouquets. Works well as an accent or specimen plant, slowly spreading ground cover, or in containers. It is not invasive. Use it beside a water feature or grow it in a pot set directly into shallow water (3-4 inches deep maximum) for an exotic look. It makes a good erosion control for moist banks and can even be used as a tall lawn substitute. Height: 18"-30" Spread: 12"-24". (Zone 4)

<u>Deschampsia caespitosa Northern Lights</u>: (*Tufted Hair Grass*) Dark green, tufted foliage with yellow variegation and pink blush on new growth or in cool weather; buff flowers in July-August; Height: 36"; Spread: 36". I Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, massing, birds. (Zone 5)

<u>Erianthus Ravennae Grass</u>: (Northern Pampas Grass) 10-14' plumes towers over 5' foliage in late summer. Plant in full sun. Use for specimen plant. (Zones 4-9):

<u>Festuca ovina glauca Elijah Blue</u>: (Blue Fescue) Medium-textured, soft, powdery blue foliage, finely-textured, cream-colored seed heads; bluish to purplish flowers in June; Height: 8"; spread: 10". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>Helictotrichon sempervirens Sapphire</u>: (Blue Oat Grass) Evergreen, metallic blue coarser foliage, golden wheat-colored seed heads; blue flowers in July-august; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, rock garden, edging. (Zone 4)

<u>Imperata cylindrica Red Baron:</u> (Japanese Blood Grass) A warm season grass with translucent, upright-growing foliage emerging bright green, with wine red-stained tips. Increasingly red as the season progresses, becoming blood red by fall. Height: 12"-24". Plant in full sun. (Zones 5-9)

<u>Leymus arenarius 'Blue Dune'</u>: (Blue Lyme Grass) Bright blue color on pointed foliage, this grass is drought and salt tolerant. Spreads by rhizomes vigorously. Flowers in summer are upright spikes and interesting. Cut back after flowering for a new flush of growth which is very attractive. Blue color is stunning! Height: 28"-38" Spread: 36"-48". (Zone 4)

<u>Miscanthus s. Arabesque</u>: (Arabesque Japanese Silver Grass) Narrow green leaf with silver midrib; spectacular fluffy plumes in August-October. Height: 3'-4'. Plant in full sun. (Zones 4-9)

Miscanthus s. Autumn Light: Good yellow fall color. Very hardy and vigorous. Height: 3'-4'. (Zones 4-9)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Gracillimus</u>: (Maiden Grass) Slender, rich green foliage; graceful, arching habit; large, showy, silver-white flowers in September; Height: 54"-72"; spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 5)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Graziella</u>: (Graziella Silver Grass) Slender, rich green foliage; graceful, arching habit; large, showy, silverwhite flowers in August; Height: 5'; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 5)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis 'Little Zebra':</u> A neat and tidy appearance, ease of maintenance, and reliable bloom makes this one of the most popular new ornamental grasses on the market. Though it looks like M. 'Zebrinus' with its distinctive gold banding, this variety

is shorter, more upright, and keeps its color all season. 'Little Zebra' flowers reliably every year in late summer, even when the weather is unusually cool. The lovely reddish purple plumes are held 1 foot above the foliage, then change to a creamy tan color in winter. Height: 3'-4' Spread: 2'-3'. (Zone 5)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Malepartus</u>: (Red-flowered Miscanthus) Narrow, green foliage; turning bronze in fall; large purplish-pink turning silver, flowers in August; Height: 5'-7'; Spread: 2'-3'. Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 5)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light':</u> An especially refined and elegant ornamental grass. Fine leaf blades are green with clean, paper—thin, white margins that give the plant a silvery cast when viewed from a distance. This plant is luminous when backlit by the early morning or late afternoon sun. It is prized for its rounded habit that never flops. Many consider 'Morning Light' to be one of the finest cultivars of Miscanthus. Height: 4'-5' Spread: 3'. (Zone 5)

GRASSES (continued)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Purpurascens</u>: (Flame Grass/Red-leaved Miscanthus) Medium green foliage with reddish tint, turning orangered in fall; silvery purple flowers in September; Height: 48"-60"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 4)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Silberfeder</u>: (Silver Feather/Silver Grass) Medium green foliage turning golden in fall; silver-white flowers in September-October; Height: 6'-7'; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 4)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Strictus</u>: (Porcupine Grass) Bright green with golden horizontal banding; stiff, upright habit; copper, turning fluffy tan, flowers in September; Height: 48"-60"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for screen, specimen, birds. (Zone 5)

<u>Miscanthus sinensis Zebrinus</u>: (Zebra Grass) Horizontal yellow bars like 'Strictus' on a more open plant form; Height: 6'-8'. (Zones 6-9)

<u>Molinia arundinacea Skyracer</u>: (Moor Grass) Light gray-green foliage, golden yellow in fall; purplish flowers in August-September; Height: 5'-7'; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, moist soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Panicum 'Dallas Blues':</u> One of the best wide-leaved, vase-shaped blue grasses available today. 'Dallas Blues' PP11202 has lofty, pastel mauve flower heads with a purple cast that are over 22" long, appearing in late summer. It also has great winter color. Switch grass gets its name from the peaceful swishing sound it makes when blowing in the wind. All parts of this grass are very sturdy, and will remain standing thru winter unless snows are heavy. This provides important cover for birds during the coldest days of winter. This grass is very versitile from a design standpoint; it is effective as a specimen, in masses, for screening, alongside ponds or streams, or even in large containers. Height: 6'-8' Spread: 4'. (Zone 4)

<u>Panicum virgatum Heavy Metal</u>: (Blue Switch Grass) Metallic powder-blue foliage, yellow in fall; whitish gray seed heads; dark burgundy, flowers in August-September; Height: 5'; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for containers, massing, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Panicum virgatum Prairie Sky</u>: (Blue Switch Grass) If you're a gardener who enjoys the blues, then you have to try this selection of our native switchgrass, prized for its powdery blue foliage. Found in Wisconsin along a railroad track by Roger Gettig, it is similar in growth habit to P. 'Heavy Metal', but taller with a less rigid habit, and much more powdery blue. In late summer, billowing plumes of amber brown top the clump.; Height: 60+"; Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for massing, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Panicum virgatum Rotstrahlbusch</u>: (Red Switch Grass) Red-tipped foliage, bright rust in fall; whitish gray seed heads; reddish flowers in August-September; Height: 48"; Spread: 24"-26". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for massing, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Panicum virgatum Shenandoah</u>: (Red Switch Grass) Dark green with reddish tones staring in July; turning burgundy in fall; pinkish flowers in July-August; Height: 48"; Spread: 24"-36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for massing, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Cassian:</u> Similar in appearance to 'Hameln', this selection blooms about 2 weeks later and holds its seed heads for a longer period. The narrow, mid-green leaves form a low, fountain-like mound. It is especially lovely when backlit by the early morning or late afternoon sun. As fall arrives, the foliage becomes streaked with red and orange, then fades to the color of straw in winter. It provides exceptional winter interest. In late summer, soft tan bottlebrush plumes with a hint of lavender are produced on arching stems. Height: 2'-3' Spread: 24"-30". (Zone 5)

<u>Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln'</u>: (Dwarf Fountain Grass) Fine-textured dark green foliage, almond in fall; whitish gray flowers in August-September; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. use for specimen, cut flowers. (Zone 5)

<u>Pennisetum orientale 'Karley Rose':</u> Deep green blades erupt into intense smoky rose-purple flowers. Long blooming. Appears to be more winter hardy than the species. Bloom time: early summer. Height: 30". (Zones 5-9)

<u>Pennisetum setaceum Rubrum</u>: (Red Fountain Grass) Burgundy foliage, bring indoors to overwinter in Wisconsin; pink to red flowers in August-October; Height: 36"-60"; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for container garden, specimen, cut flowers. (Zone 9)

<u>Phalaris Dwarf Garters</u>: (Dwarf Ribbon Grass) Very similar, but more compact in form than Picta. White striped, variegated leaves and seed flowers that emerge a soft white color, turning brown in late summer. Height: 12"-24". Plant in full sun to part shade. (Zones 4-9)

<u>Phalaris arundinacea 'Picta'</u>: (Ribbon Grass) Spreading, white and green striped foliage, pale brown seed heads; soft white flowers in July; Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 24"-36"++. Plant in average, well-drained to wet soil in full sun to part shade. Use for groundcover, marginal plant, erosion control. (Zone 3)

<u>Phalaris arundinacea 'Strawberries & Cream'</u>: (Ribbon Grass) Very showy, creamy white variegated green leaves tinged rose pink. Tough, spreading grass. Leaf color lends itself well to mixed container plantings. Flowers appear in early summer (May-June). Height 2-3'. Hardy in Zones 4-8. Grows best in full sun to light shade. (Zone 4)

<u>Schizachyrium scoparium Little Bluestem</u>: A throwback to the American tallgrass prairie, it is a clump forming, fine textured grass. Ideal for managed meadows, it is tolerant of varying moisture conditions. Height: 48". (Zones 4-10)

<u>Schizachyrium scoparium 'Blaze' Little Bluestem</u>: Better fall color than parent. A throwback to the American tallgrass prairie, it is a clump forming, fine textured grass. Ideal for managed meadows, it is tolerant of varying moisture conditions. Height: 48". (Zones 4)

<u>Schizachyrium scoparium 'The Blues' Little Bluestem</u>: Stronger Blue coloration. A throwback to the American tallgrass prairie, it is a clump forming, fine textured grass. Ideal for managed meadows, it is tolerant of varying moisture conditions. Height: 4' (Zones 4)

<u>Sorghastrum nutans Sioux Blue</u>: (Indian Grass) Bright blue-gray foliage, burnt orange in fall; copper-brown seed heads; showy tan-yellow flowers in August-September; Height: 5'; Spread: 24"-30". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for massing, specimen, cut flowers, dried flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>Sporobolus heterolepsis</u>: (Northern Dropseed, Prairie Dropseed) Fine-textured, emerald green foliage, golden in fall; a Wisconsin Native plant; sweetly-scented, dark green flowers in August-September; Height: 24"-36"; spread: 12"-15". Plant in any well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for native prairie, border garden. (Zone 4)

GYPSOPHILA (Baby's Breath)

paniculata Snowflake (White): Fine, narrow, gray-green foliage; semi-double to double white flowers in June-July; Height: 36"-48"; Spread: 36"-48". Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers, dried flower. (Zone 4)

<u>repens Alba</u>: (Creeping Baby's Breath) Mat-forming, gray-green foliage; white flowers in June-July; Height: 6"-10"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, dry soil in full sun. use for rock garden, edging, front of border, rock wall. (Zone 3)

HEDERA (English Ivv)

<u>helix Hebron</u>: (Hardy English Ivy) Dark green evergreen foliage with lighter new foliage; no flowers; Height: 6"-8"; Spread: 18"-24". Plant in any moist soil in part shade to full shade. Use for containers, groundcover, vine. (Zone 4)

HELENIUM (Helen's Flower/Sneezeweed)

<u>autumnale Red/Gold Hybrids</u>: Lance-shaped, erect foliage; red and gold shades, flowers in August-September; Height: 36"-60"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained to moist soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

HELIOPSIS (False Sunflower)

<u>helianthoides Summer Sun</u>: (Rough Heliopsis) Mid-green foliage on strong, sturdy stems; bright yellow flowers in June-August; Height: 24"-36"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zone 4)

<u>helianthoides Summer Nights</u>: (Rough Heliopsis) Red-tinged foliage on strong, sturdy reddish stems; deep yellow flowers with mahogany red centers in June-August; Height: 36"-48"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, cut flowers. (Zones 3-9)

HELLEBORUS (Lenten Rose) Perrenial of the Year 2005

<u>orientalis 'Blue Lady':</u> Deep blue-purple flowers are 2" across, nicely rounded & beautifully contrasted with a crown of golden stamens. Outward facing, they rise up nicely above the large & lustrous, rich green (& evergreen) foliage, blooming Winter thru early Spring. The foliage forms a good sized, bushy clump to 2' across & remains attractive year around, making a nice shade groundcover under trees or near the front porch. Highly drought tolerant & deer proof. (Zone 5)

orientalis 'Pink Lady': Same as above but pink. Highly drought tolerant & deer proof. (Zone 5)

orientalis 'Red Lady': Same as above but Red. Highly drought tolerant & deer proof. (Zone 5)

<u>orientalis 'White Spotted Lady':</u> Same as above but Red markings on a yellowish white leaf. Highly drought tolerant & deer proof. (Zone 5)

<u>x 'Ivory Prince':</u> True regal beauty whose ivory flowers are flushed with pink, and streaked with green and rose hues that deepen with time. The outward-facing, long lasting blooms combined with blue green foliage complete the picture of an elegant plant. Highly drought tolerant & deer proof. (Zone 4)

HEMEROCALLIS (Daylily)

(Creams/Whites)

<u>Gentle Shepherd</u>: 5" lightly-ruffled off-white flowers blended into a subtle green throat, flowering in early June-mid July. Height: 26". Plant in well-drained soil in full sun or light shade. Use for mixed perennial border, mass plantings, containers. (Zones 3-9)

<u>Big Bird tetraploid</u>: **Huge** yellow flowers in mid season. Height: 34". Plant in well-drained soil in full sun or light shade. Use for mixed perennial border, mass plantings, containers. (Zones 3-9)

<u>Big Smile</u>: 4 inch fragrant lemon yellow flowers with heavily ruffled edgeds of candy pink. Dormant variety. July-August; Height: 24-30"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectarous plant. (Zone 4)

<u>Black Eyed Stella</u>: Yellow 'Stella' colored flower with Dark Red center. The hallmark of this winner in the 'Landscape' Category is its near-continuous blooming. This very first All-American winner was the result of over 10 years of breeding by Jack Roberson. Created from Stella de Oro, the most successfully daylily in history, Black Eyed Stella was the result of over three thousand hybrid crosses. Blooms Early, 3 1/2" Eyed Blooms, Height: 12"-18"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectarous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Chicago Sunrise</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; classified as a tetraploid; 6", golden apricot flowers in July; Height; 24"-28"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Eenie Weenie</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; classified as a dwarf miniature; 13/4", yellow self flowers in June-July; Height: 10"-12"; Spread: 16"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, edging, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

First Knight: Large Ruffled Edge flower; light cream yellow with gold edge, slightly fragrant in July-August; Height: 30"; Spread: 30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectarous plant. (Zone 4)

<u>Happy Returns</u>: Clean, lemon yellow flowers from May until hard frost; a Stella d'Oro descendant. Height: 18"-20". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, edging, groundcover, nectarous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Hyperion</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 5", fragrant lemon-yellow flowers in July-August; Height: 36"-40"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Mary Todd</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; classified as a tetraploid; 6", butter-yellow self, flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-26"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Stella D'Oro (Yellow)</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; classified as a dwarf miniature; 2³/₄", gold self, flowers in June, reblooming; Height: 12"-15"; Spread: 16"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

(Pinks/Peach)

<u>Catherine Woodbury</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 6", light lavender-pink flowers in July; Height: 26"-30"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Daria Anita:</u> Overlapping pink, fringed petals with yellow edges, blooms early to mid summer; Height: 18"-24"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Daring Deception</u>: 5.5", dusty cream-pink self with a large, dark purple eye and green throat, Petals overlap, creating a uniquely shaped eyezone, pie crust edges of petals, blooms from early to midsummer repeat bloomer. Height 24" (Zone 3)

<u>Hall's Pink</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 5", salmon-pink flowers in July; Height: 18"-24"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Patricia Fay</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; rose self with small yellow green throat, flowers in July; Height: 36"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Strawberry Candy</u>: .5", strawberry-pink self with a bright raspberry-red eyezone notched at the midribs, Orange-gold watermark and a small green throat. Tightly compressed ruffles on the raspberry-red edged petals; smooth sepals. Blooms in early to midsummer; rebloomer. Extended bloom--flowers last at least 16 hrs. each. Height 26" (Zone 3)

<u>Frans Hals</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 5", bright rust and orange bi-color, flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

Autumn Red: Deep red to maroon flowers in midseason. Good for mass planting. (Zone 3)

<u>Baja</u>: 6", showy blood red tepals with a bright yellow halo and midribs, and a green throat, Slightly recurved tepals with smooth edges; Flowers have a velvety texture, are sunfast, and have fantastic form. Blooms in early to midsummer; rebloomer. Height 26" (Zone 3)

<u>Chicago Apache:</u> Vigorous grower, scarlet ted petals, attracts butterflies/hummingbirds, flowers in June-July; Height: 30"-36"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Mauna Loa:</u> Gold blend with red wire edges and light green throat, flowers in June-July; Height: 30"-36"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Pardon Me</u>: Small 3" bright red flowers, broad petalled, with yellow green throat. Long blooming, beginning midseason; often reblooms in fall – one of the best daylilies on the market. Height: 18"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Red Magic</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 4", maroon-red with yellow throat, flowers in June-July; Height: 30"-36"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Sammy Russell</u>: Red flowers in mid to late season. Height: 18"-20". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zones 3-9)

<u>South Seas</u>: Slightly fragrant, vibrant coral flowers, rebloomer, drought tolerant, floweres in mid to late season. Height: 30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zones 3-9)

(Deep Reds/Purples)

Lil Missy: 3" blooms of purple with white edges flower early to mid-summer. Height: 16". (Zone 4)

<u>Little Grapette</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; classified as a dwarf miniature; 2", grape self flowers in June; Height: 12"; Spread: 16"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Little Wine Cup</u>: Early 3" wine cherry-red flowers with green throat, rebloomer. Height: 20". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Purple d'Oro</u>: A vibrant midsummer display of purple flowers held high above mounds of narrow, grassy-green foliage. Height: 12"-18"; Spread 18". Extremely hardy; plant in well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for borders, background plantings or naturalizing. (Zone 3)

<u>Summer Wine</u>: Sturdy clumps of grassy foliage; 5½", purple-red with green throat, flowers in July; Height: 24"; Spread: 18"-30". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

<u>Tooth</u>: Large 6" lavender flower, rebloomer, flowers in summer; Height: 30"; Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, nectareous plant. (Zone 3)

HERBS

<u>Onion Chives (Allium schoenoprasum)</u>: Narrow, tubular foliage; especially good with potatoes and eggs; use for garnish, soups, salads, soft cheese, sauces; edible rose-purple flowers in June: Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 12". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for containers, culinary herb, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

<u>Garlic Chives (Allium tuberosum)</u>: Grass-like foliage; delicate garlic-flavor; leaves and flowers buds used in soft cheeses, salads, stir-fry; edible, fragrant white flowers in July; Height: 18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for border garden, containers, culinary herb. (Zone 4)

<u>Dill, Fernleaf (Anethum graveolens)</u>: Extra finely cut foliage; sprigs of flower heads are used in pickling; seeds and leaves used with potatoes, eggs, fish, and seafood; tiny greenish yellow flowers in Summer; Height: 18"; Spread: 12"-18". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for culinary herb. (Annual)

HERBS (Continued)

<u>Marjoram (Sweet Marjoram) (Marjorana onites)</u>: Delicate foliage; use in meat dishes, tomato soup, pasta; use to flavor oil and vinegar, dried for potpourri; light purple flowers in Summer; Height: 24"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for aromatic herb, culinary herb, medicinal herb. (Zone 8)

<u>Mint/Chocolate Peppermint (Mentha x piperita)</u>: Green with chocolate vein coloration, toothed, spreading foliage; use in jellies, sauces for lamb dishes, herb teas, and iced drinks, candied and garnishes; edible, purple flowers in Summer; Height: 18"-24"; spread: 24"-36"++. Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to full sun. Use for groundcover, aromatic herb, confectionary, culinary herb. (Zone 3)

<u>Mint/Spearmint (Mentha spicata)</u>: Bright green, toothed, spreading foliage; use in jellies, sauces for lamb dishes, herb teas, and iced drinks, candied and garnishes; edible, purple flowers in Summer; Height: 18"-24"; spread: 24"-36"++. Plant in rich, moist soil in part shade to full sun. Use for groundcover, aromatic herb, confectionary, culinary herb. (Zone 3)

<u>Oregano Greek Strain (Origanum heracleoticum)</u>: Aromatic, gray-green, spreading foliage; often used dried in strongly flavored dishes; important herb in Italian, Greek, and Mexican cuisine; edible, white to purple flowers in summer; Height: 24"; Spread: 24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun. Use for edible, aromatic herb, culinary herb, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Rosemary, Common (rosmarinus officinalis)</u>: bluish green, shrubby foliage; fresh sprigs for vinegar, wine or oil; use fresh or dried for meats, soups and stews; oils for toiletries; edible, blue flowers in Summer; Height: 30"; Spread: 30". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun. use for containers, aromatic, culinary, medicinal, frost sensitive sub-shrub. (Zone 8).

<u>Sage, Common (Salvia officinalis)</u>: Downy, gray foliage; leaves used in sausage, stuffing, as a tea; edible, blue flowers in Summer; Height: 30"; Spread: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for border, containers, aromatic, culinary, medicinal, nectareous plant. (Zone 4)

<u>Sage, Tricolor (Salvia officinalis Tricolor)</u>: White and purple variegated foliage; leaves used in sausage, stuffing, as a tea; edible, blue flowers in Summer; Height: 24"; Spread: 36". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for border, containers, aromatic, culinary, medicinal, nectareous plant. (Zone 5)

<u>Tarragon, French (Artemisia dracunculus)</u>: Slender, dark green anise-flavored leaves; use fresh or dried for chicken, eggs, sauces, salad dressing, mustard; no flowers. Height: 30"-36"; Spread: 12"-15". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for border garden, culinary herb. (Zone 4)

<u>Thyme, English (Thymus vulgaris)</u>: Aromatic, gray-green shrubby foliage; an essential ingredient of "Bouquet garni"; use to flavor soups, marinades, stuffings and vegetables; edible, lavender flowers in July; Height: 10"-15"; spread: 12"-24". Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for containers, groundcover, aromatic herb, culinary herb, medicinal herb. (Zone 5)

<u>Thyme, Lemon (Thymus x citriodorus)</u>: Lemon-scented, shrubby foliage; use fresh or dried for fish, stuffings for poultry and vegetables; edible, lavender flowers in July; Height: 10"-15"; spread: 12"-24:. Plant in average, well-drained soil in full sun to part sun. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, culinary herb. (Zone 5)

HEUCHERA

americana Dales Strain: Green leafed with veil coloration, fall color is orange/red, very attractive green. Height 10" (Zone 3)

<u>micrantha Palace Purple (Alum Root)</u>: Bronze-red foliage; larger in the shade; whitish flowers in May-June; Height: 24"; spread: 12"-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>sanguinea Bressingham Hybrids (Coral Bells)</u>: Compact clumps of round-lobed, green foliage; light pink to dark red shades, flowers in May-June: Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden, edging, cut flowers, nectareous plant. (Zone 4)

sanguinea Splendens: Scarlet blooms in May-July. Height: 15". Plant in full sun or part shade. (Zones 4-9)

<u>x Amber Waves (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: Warm amber-gold, ruffled leaves; Cream flowers in May-June; Height: 30"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Can Can (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: Tight ruffled mound of dark purple with green veins strongly contrasting over very light background leaf colors of pale blue, purple, and green. A Gold Medal winner in Europe; small light flowers in May-June; Height: 10"; Spread: 16". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Cappuccino:</u> More sun resistant than many cultivars, ruffled and cut leaves, light bronze plant with pink flowers that appear in early June to early August, covering 50 percent of the plant, Height 30", (Zone 4)

<u>x Cherries Jubillee:</u> Ruffled, warm brownish leaves and conspicuous cherry-red flowers; small light flowers in May-June; Height: 10"; Spread: 16". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4) **HEUCHERA (continued)**

<u>x Chocolate Ruffles (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: Chocolate foliage with burgundy reverse, ruffled edges of leaves; white flowers in May-June; Height: 30"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Chocolate Veil (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: Deep Chocolate foliage with burgundy reverse; white flowers in May-June; Height: 30"; Spread: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Coral Cloud:</u> Light green leaves with silver overtones and bright purple-pink flowers that bloom from early June to late July, covering 50 percent of the plant. Height 28", (Zone 4)

<u>x Fireworks:</u> matte green leaves have deeply frilled edges that reveal their wine red reverses. The coral pink flowers are a useful color break from the usually greenish-white flowers of the darker Heucheras. Height 17"-20" (Zone 4)

<u>x Frosted Violet (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: Pink-purple in spring, but gradually mature to plum-purple with dark veining; small light pink flowers in May-June; Height: 30"; Spread: 12-24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Jade Gloss</u>: A midsize variety with leaves that are almost entirely glossy silver with a dark green tracery of veins. In late spring and into summer it has sturdy upright stems of showy pale pink flowers from pink buds. In bright sun the upper sides of the leaves become suffused with red during the summer. The leaves are very weather resistant and the bright color lasts through winter. Excellent in containers.. A real winner! Height: (foliage) 11", (Flower) 18". (Zones 3-8)

<u>x June Bride</u>: Sprays of dainty white flowers on branched spikes in May-July. Height: 15"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Use for borders, cuttings. (Zone 4)

<u>x Lime Rickey (Hybrid Coral Bells)</u>: heavily ruffled chartreuse leaves; white flowers in May-June; Height: 8-12"; Spread: 15-18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for border garden, rock garden. (Zone 4)

<u>x Marmalade:</u> Foliage of this selection ranges in color from umber to deep sienna. The rich, shiny, undulating leaves are of heavy substance, helping them to stand up to inclement weather. A plethora of reddish-brown flowers appear on 16 inch scapes from late spring to early summer. Height 10", Spread 12" (Zone 4)

<u>x Mystic Angel:</u> bright silver-green foliage, accented with dark veining and green edges, this wonderful plant is ideal in the front of beds, along borders and in mixed pots. Spectacular effects are created by planting in "Moon" gardens (gardens which come to life when the moon is in its fuller stages), or in "White" gardens. Height 10", Spread 12" (Zone 4)

<u>x Pewter Moon</u>: very attractive foliage, black-green veining marbled through pewter above, and purple undersides. Creamy pink flowers in July-August; Height: 12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for perennial border, containers, rock garden. (Zones 4-8)

<u>x Plum Pudding</u>: Compact plant with silvery plum-purple foliage, flowers in May-July; Height: 8". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Use for perennial border, containers, rock garden. (Zones 4-8)

<u>x Purple Mountain Majesty:</u> compact purple foliage with light silver markings and large white flowers on erect 18 to 24" stems in late spring. The flowers are almost globular in shape and about 1/2" (12 mm) long. 'Purple Mountain Majesty has been more sun tolerant for us in the past several years than almost any of the other new heuchera hybrids. Height 24" (Zone 3)

<u>x Regal Robe</u>: New growth has a metallic lavender sheen that changes colors somewhat with the seasons. Foliage persists in winter even in cold climates, but should be protected from drying winds. Flowers are chartreuse on tall spikes. Deep purple underside. Height 24" (Zone 3)

<u>x Silver Scrolls:</u> enchanting looking heuchera, this selection displays leaves with such crisp color patterning that they look like little stained glass windows. They range in color from season to season in response to changing light levels. In spring, they are deep grape purple with a heavy steel-grey overlay and crisp veination. Their undersides are royal purple, revealed by the curling of the leaves. During the winter, the foliage turns to a rich violet hue. Height 12", Spread 14" (Zone 3)

x Snow Angel: Compact green and white variegation with red flowers, very exciting. Height 15-20" (Zone 3)

<u>x Stormy Seas:</u> Beautiful ruffled foliage blends shades of pewter, burgundy and olive. An excellent landscape plant with good form and extreme vigor. Foliage Height: 9"; Flower Height: 12-24". (Zones 3-8)

HEUCHERELLA

<u>Stoplight:</u> You'll stop in your tracks when you see the new H. 'Stoplight' PPAF! Radiant yellow leaves have a large, dark red blotch in the center which feathers out through the veins. The foliage of this selection is larger and more yellow with a darker blotch than H. 'Sunspot' PPAF. White flowers are produced on 12 inch tall stalks beginning in late spring. Height 6", Spread 6-10" (Zone 4)

<u>Sunspot:</u> Electric yellow foliage with blood-red center patches is nearly blinding! As the heat of summer arrives, it becomes more of a straw-yellow color, but is still outstanding. Spectacular bright pink flowers. Height 6", Spread 6-10" (Zone 3)

HIBISCUS

X Disco Belle Pink: Compact, vigorous, sturdy, erect but somewhat shrubby, woody-based hibiscus cultivar that typically grows to only 2.5' tall and features dinner plate-sized, 5-petaled, hollyhock-like flowers (to 9" diameter) which are among the largest flowers produced by any perennial. Flowers are pink on the edges fading to white with a deep pinkish-red central eye. Individual flowers are very short-lived (1-2 days), but one or more flowers usually open each day, in succession, over a long mid-summer to early fall bloom period. Height 24"-30", Spread 24" (Zone 4)

X Disco Belle Mix: Same as above but with reds, whites, pinks and shades of each. Height 24"-30", Spread 24" (Zone 4)

X Disco Belle Rosy Red: Same as above but rosy red. Height 24"-30", Spread 24" (Zone 4)

X Disco Belle White: Same as above but white. Height 24"-30", Spread 24" (Zone 4)

HOSTA

Albo-marginata (Wavy Hosta): Dark green foliage with white margin; lavender flowers in July-august; Height: 24"-30"; spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>August Moon</u>: Medium-large hosta with cupped, heart-shaped, golden yellow leaves. The early spring foliage has a greener color. Relatively sun tolerant. White flowers. Height: 20"; Spread: 30". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>montana Aureo-marginata (Mountain Hosta)</u>: Large leaves with irregular yellow margin; very pale lavender to near white flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 48". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>x Big Daddy</u>: Deep blue, round, puckered foliage; white flowers in July-August; Height: 26"; Spread: 49". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>Big Foot</u>: Large mound of slug-resistant, blue green foliage; near white flowers in June-July on 28" scapes. 12" by 8" wide, thick, deep blue-green leaves. Height 24"; Spread: 55". Excellent background plant. (Zone 3)

<u>x Blue Angel</u>: Huge blue leaves with heavy texture; white flowers in July-August; Height: 30"; Spread: 87". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to full shade. Use for border garden, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>x Blue Cadet</u>: Rich blue, heavy-textured, oval leaves; dark lavender flowers in July; Height: 10"-15"; Spread: 38". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Blue Jay:</u> Intense powder-blue round leaves form a tight 2' wide mound. In late spring, the clump is topped with light lavender flowers...great among other small hostas. Height 10", Spread 24" (Zone 3)

<u>Blue Wedgewood:</u> This spectacular grey-blue hybrid from the late Eric Smith of England makes a clump to 40" in width and still remains one of the most popular powder-blue hostas today. The wedge-shaped leaves serve as a nice backdrop for the soft lavender flowers in late summer on 2' tall scapes. Height 18", Spread 34" (Zone 3)

<u>Bright Lights:</u> Vigorous, thick heart-shaped leaves, puckered and gold leaves with a streaky blue margin, very striking. White bell shaped flowers in midsummer. Height 15" (Zone 3)

<u>Camelot:</u> Striking blue heart-shaped leaves with excellent substance, slug resistant. Light lavender flowers in early summer. Height 16", Spread 22" (Zone 3)

<u>Cascades:</u> Upright mound with the end of each leaf cascading downward. Pure white flowers top white flower stems providing perfect harmony to the landscape display. Green edges with a prominent white mid section. Height 18", Spread 24" (Zone 3)

<u>Cherry Berry</u>: Small-medium hosta. Pointed elliptic leaves, mostly white with irregular dark-green margins. Violet flowers top red-spotted scapes. Cherry red seed pods in fall. Height: 16"; Spread: 34". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Diamond Tiarra:</u> Medium green leaves with crisp white, wavy margins Rapidly grows into a neat, dense mound of variegated foliage. Medium to bright purple flowers. Height: 14"; Spread: 28". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>sieboldiana Elegans</u>: Large hostas with huge glaucous heart-shaped, gray-green leaves, heavy in substance with a deeply puckered texture. Regarded as the archetypal hosta. A late sprouting species. White flowers with hints of lavender. Height: 20"; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Emerald Tiarra:</u> Forms a low, dense mound of gold-centered, green-margined foliage; a vigorous grower Pale to bright purple flowers mid to late summer; may rebloom in fall. Height: 14"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

<u>Fair Maiden:</u> Medium green foliage emerges in spring with wide, streaked, yellow margins which pure white as the season progresses. Lavender, tubular flowers appear on 16" scapes in midsummer. Height: 14"; Spread: 18". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen, cut flowers. (Zone 3)

<u>fortunei Fire and Ice (Fortune's Hosta)</u>: Pure white foliage with dark green margin; white stems, lavender flowers in July-August; Height: 30"; spread: 20". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>Fire Island:</u> Brilliant yellow leaves are accented by light red petioles with red coloration extending into the base of the leaves. Especially intense in t the spring. Lavender blooms to the clump in summer. Height: 18"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen, cut flowers. (Zone 4)

fortunei France (Fortune's Hosta): Dark green foliage with narrow white margin; lavender flowers in July-August; Height: 20"-24"; spread: 45". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, groundcover, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>sieboldiana Frances Williams (Seersucker Hosta)</u>: Large blue-gray foliage with gold margin; pale lavender to near white flowers in July-August; Height: 26"-30"; Spread: 60". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>Fragrant Blue:</u> Chalky blue leaves are slightly wavy and of good substance. They retain their color well into the summer. Tends to send up new blue leaves throughout the growing season. Leaves are of good substance, corrugated, and slightly cupped. Fragrant, light lavender flowers turn darker as they age. Attracts both hummingbirds and songbirds. Height 18", Spread 30". (Zone 3)

<u>Fragrant Bouquet:</u> Light apple-green leaves with wide, pale yellow to cream margins. Leaves are broadly ovate, wavy, and of good substance. Slug resistant and a strong grower. Large, near white flowers. Award: American Hosta Growers Hosta of the Year Award, '98. Height 20", Spread 36". (Zone 3)

<u>sieboldii Ginko Craig (Siebold Hosta)</u>: Lance-shaped leaves with white margin; purple flowers in July-August; Height: 10"-12"; Spread: 33". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, edging, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Gold Drop</u>: Green-gold rosette to 6". Mauve flowers. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Gold Edger</u>: Heart-shaped golden foliage; pale lavender flowers in June-July; Height: 12'; spread: 30". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging, groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>x Golden Tiara</u>: Green heart-shaped foliage with gold margin; purple with white veining, flowers in July-August; Height: 12"-18"; Spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, edging. (Zone 3)

<u>fortunei Gold Standard (Fortune's Hosta)</u>: Gold foliage with green margin; pale lavender flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-30"; spread: 36". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>Grand Tiara:</u> Wider and more pronounced bright gold margin with a narrow dark green center then 'Golden Tiara'. Lavender flowers in midsummer. Rapidly grows into a nice mound. A real eye catcher! Height 18", Spread 30". (Zone 4)

<u>sieboldiana Great Expectations (Seersucker Hosta)</u>: Yellow-cream foliage with wide, irregular blue-green margins; near white flowers in July-August; Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 50". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>Masquerade:</u> Miniature Hosta. Forms clumps of tiny white centered leaves edged by a green margin. Purple flowers in summer. Very flashy! Height 6", Spread 8". (Zone 4)

<u>medio picta:</u> (medio varigata) Varigated centers with green margins; pale lavender flowers in July-August; Height: 12-24"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>fortunei Night Before Christmas (Fortune's Hosta)</u>: Dark green, pointed foliage with narrow creamy-white to white center; pale lavender flowers in June; Height: 24"; Spread: 24". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part shade. Use for border garden, containers, specimen, groundcover. (Zone 3)

<u>Olive Bailey Langdon:</u> Wide gold margins, blue green center, heavily corrugated, thick substance. Similar to 'Frances Williams' but its margins brighten much later, thereby reducing the so-called 'spring burn' problem. Height 28", Spread 48". (Zone 3)

<u>On Stage:</u> Late emerging, reverse-variegated sport of H. m. 'Aureo-marginata'. Rugose leaves are radiant yellow, changing to either cream or chartreuse. <u>Remember Me:</u> Leaves emerge in spring bright yellow with a narrow, dusty green edge. By early summer, leaves have dark bluegreen margins with some streaking into the large, snow white centers; appears white from a distance. Light lavender flowers. Height 12", Spread 20". (Zone 3)

<u>Revolution:</u> Dark green leaves have large, cream centers with soft green speckling in the spring; speckles darken by midsummer. Leaves are of heavy substance; possibly a tetraploid. Lavender, tubular flowers in midsummer. Height 12", Spread 20". (Zone 3)

<u>Royal Standard</u>: Medium green foliage; large fragrant white flowers in August-September; Height: 24"-30"; Spread: 50". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part shade to part sun. Use for border garden, containers, groundcover, specimen. (Zone 3)

<u>minor Bowles Variety</u>: Glossy, evergreen, mat-forming foliage tending to grow in mounds; deep lilac-blue flowers in May-June; Height: 6"-8"; Spread: 36"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. (Zone 4)

<u>minor Illumination</u>: Stunning gold centered leaves with a dark green border virtually illuminate the landscape; mat-forming foliage; lilac-blue flowers in May-June; Height: 4"-6"; Spread: 36"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in full shade to part sun. Use for groundcover. (Zone 4)

VIOLA (Violet, Pansy)

cornuta Blue Perfection: Blue, slightly fragrant flowers, bloom without a rest from spring to fall. Height: 8". (Zones 5-8)

cornuta Columbine: Purple and white striped fragrant flowers; plant in shade to part shade. Height: 8".(Zone 5)

<u>Etain:</u> Rare and choice, this beautiful English hybrid has extra large 1-3/4" pale lemon blooms with contrasting lavender margins. Very fragrant, flowers bloom from May – October. Height: 8"-10". (Zones 5-8)

<u>tricolor (Johnny-Jump-Up)</u>: Round, tufted foliage; edible, purple/lavender/yellow flowers in May; Height: 6"-8"; Spread: 10"-12". Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun. Use for border garden, containers, edging. (Zone 5)

<u>King Henry</u>: Deep violet-blue, velvety flowers with bright yellow eyes are striking planted with spring bulbs in cold climates; flowers Spring to Early Summer & Fall; height 4" to 8" (Zone 4)

cornuta Purple Showers: Electric purple slightly fragrant 2" flowers bloom without a rest from spring to fall. Height: 8". (Zones 5-8)

WALDSTEINIA (Barren Strawberry)

<u>ternata</u>: Evergreen foliage; yellow flowers in May-June; Height: 4"-6"; Spread: 12"-18"++. Plant in rich, well-drained soil in part sun to part shade. Use for rock garden, edging, groundcover, rock wall. (Zone 3
